ONE WAY EXPERIENCE....

...will be open to the public at TRINITY St John sub Castro from Saturday Ist April through to Good Friday. The ONE WAY experience is a journey through the life of Jesus. Using all your senses, you taste, touch, smell, feel and see scenes from His birth to resurrection. ONE WAY is great for everyone - you could use it as a reflective space in Holy Week to prepare for Easter; you could bring children or grandchildren to learn about Jesus; you could bring a non-Christian friend and invite them on the journey to find out about Jesus.

We will be needing people to help at ONE WAY and welcome people as they arrive and chat with them afterwards. We will also need story-tellers to help the week before, $27^{th} - 30^{th}$ March, when we have a number of schools coming through ONE WAY. If you offered to be a story-teller, you would sit within ONE WAY and open up that scene from Jesus' life to the children (in small groups) as they journeyed ONE WAY. Whether you could give an hour or two or a whole morning / afternoon, that would be great. Please email Anita or Richard if you would like to know more or get involved.
