# LIVING IN LOVE AND FAITH (LLF)

For a number of years the Church of England has been encouraging and engaging in conversation and listening to one another around issues of sexuality, marriage, relationships, identity. In June we will be engaging in the LLF conversation in two ways. On Sundays 11<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> June our sermons will be on themes of Holiness, Marriage & Singleness and Desire. We recognise that our morning services are not conducive for lengthy conversation and extended listening to one another, so we will have three evening sessions when we can listen, talk and ask questions. These will be on Wednesdays 14<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup> June and 12<sup>th</sup> July at TRINITY Southover. Refreshments will be served from 7.30pm and we will formally start at 8.00pm. These are for everyone (and individual Home Groups will not be meeting during these weeks) and the evenings will enable us to listen to one another, ask questions and talk together.

In preparation for the first evening session on 14<sup>th</sup> June, we would like to have your questions in advance and anonymously. Your questions can be on anything to do with the living in love and faith topic, such as sexuality, gender, marriage, identity, relationships, what scripture says or does not say etc. You do not need to put your name to your questions. Please put your questions on the A6 cards at our services and put them into the white boxes at the back of the church. If you want to talk about this subject separately, please contact Anita, Paul or Jeremy.
