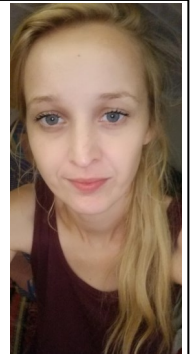


Hello, my name is Lisa Buyinza; serving in Uganda through establishing Pearl of Grace Ministries.

PREPARING TO LAUNCH

We are currently in the process transitioning into a position for launching the ministry here in Uganda. In particular I am liaising with a lawyer to secure all the necessary documentation for registering an NGO; hopefully by the end of this year.

TRANSITION OFFICE SPACE

I enquired about a nearby apartment to rent as a temporary office and a base through this period. It will give us a space to use for the girls' programs, until we've registered the organisation. Since prayer & the Word of God is a central aspect of the preparation process, we will also utilise the office space to establish an altar of intercession for POG vision.

POG COVERING

In January I came under Phaneroo International Ministries as our church covering – both personally and for POG ministry. It is amazing to see a powerful move of God and the beginnings of revival being ignited in the nation through the message & work of this ministry. Phaneroo particularly share a passion for reaching the children & youth of Uganda in schools & universities, as a core part of their vision.

CHARIS BIBLE COLLEGE

The leadership of Phaneroo church received training from Charis Bible College, Kampala – founded by missionary Andrew Warmack. This year I began studying a Course at Charis Bible College to further equip me in the knowledge of God & practical training for ministry.



POG GIRLS

We continue to journey and walk alongside our 4 girls that remained with us from our season in Gomba. It's such a joy to see them growing in their sense of identity & purpose; particularly the 'big sister' of the group – who will be completing her S6 exams this year. We are prayerfully considering whether she will pursue Bible college at Charis before University.
