PHANEROO INTERNATIONAL MINISTRIES CHURCH

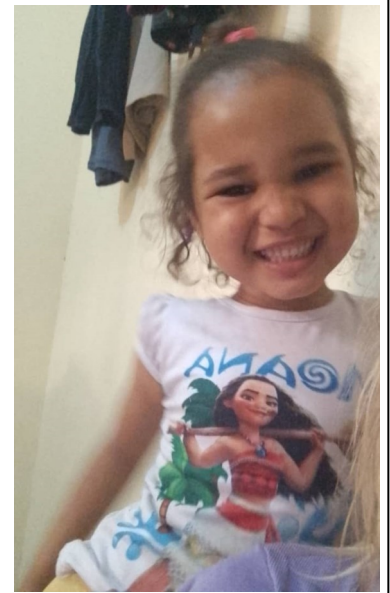

ECO TIP FOR AUGUST FROM A ROCHA UK



Assist local wildlife during very hot weather. Provide hedgehogs with hedgehog biscuits (available at many pet stores and online) or dog biscuits (small/crumbed) as their prey of slugs, snails and worms diminishes, and ensure a safe exit for them and other small mammals if you have a garden pond. Help garden birds by maintaining a filled bird bath and supplying supplementary food including black sunflower seeds, pinhead oatmeal, soaked sultanas, raisins, currants, mealworms, waxworms, and a nutritious seed mixture, when natural supplies become scarce.

'If they see you holding a Bible like this in Iran,' he says, 'they kill you.' Many churches across the country are welcoming refugees from Iran, many fleeing religious persecution in their own country. They come for the welcome and stay for the word. Bible Society can provide free bibles in Persian; these are prohibited in their own country. Please pray for these new converts and their families back home who may be facing persecution.



Ethiopia is about 5 times larger than the UK, with a population of over 120 million. More than 80% live in rural areas. One in three people live on less than US\$1.90 per day. TLM partners with ALERT hospital in Addis Ababa, the capital, treating Leprosy and addressing the challenges of exclusion and stigma facing Leprosy affected people in rural communities. TLM also works in Amhara region of Ethiopia, where since April 2023 there has been armed conflict, please pray for peace.




With the summer holidays, we have seen an increase in tourists and visitors to Beachy Head. The cliff edges are very busy with people taking photos, ignoring ropes and wire fences, endangering themselves and making the work of chaplains difficult. The Beachy Head road attracts, in the evening, a number of young people who drive at high speeds in cars and motorbikes resulting in some accidents and, sadly, some deaths. Pray for safety and protection for our chaplains as they search for anyone in real need.
