At Pearls of Grace we have begun the new year in celebratory fashion, with our longest standing POG daughter, **Immy**, having recently completed her S6 examinations (A level equivalent) and now studying at Charis Bible College for her S6 vacation, whilst participating in POG Leadership Academy. – Another young leader, Tina, also graduated from catering college, supported on our POG outreach program. Tina was a volunteer for POG who ran skills sessions during our holiday programs. She is now a youth leader for “Revealed Youth Ministry”. Her long-term vision is to start an evangelical community café that mentors younger girls, whilst imparting her catering skills to them.

We will continue to walk with Tina; facilitating skills workshops and “Girls Prayer Banquets” to impact girls from Revealed Youth Group and from the community. Tina & Immy have been supported through our POG New Vision New Mission mentorship program that aims to align young people with their purpose.

UPDATE FROM HANNAH COLPUS, SERVING WITH GO MAKE A DIFFERENCE TANZANIA

Every Wednesday we lead a children’s group at one of the churches we go to, where we tell a short Bible story and then do some colouring and play games outside. The kids are all so lovely and full of energy and we’ve gotten to know them really well over the past few weeks. It’s also a good opportunity to encourage some of the older children to play and ‘act like kids’, as many of them have lots of responsibility having to look after their younger siblings.

We have also been helping with the development of the GoMad workshop. We helped lay the concrete inside the workshop and a few of us painted the outside doors. The workshop will be used to sell wood that’s been cut down from the tree plantations GoMad oversee. Selling wood brings in a lot of money, so the workshop is a great investment into helping some local people receive a steady income.

The photo is from the Leprosy community after we were able to hand out walking sticks for the people there - they were all very happy to receive them! There was a lady the week before who was crawling on the floor....with the walking stick she was able to walk and was overjoyed.



UPDATES AND PRAYER REQUESTS FOR MISSION PARTNERS



We are very thankful for the positive start that we have had to 2025, with ten new tenancies already in place, as well as several new volunteers who have come onboard. Please pray for the team overseeing funding applications, and also for the team looking at IT solutions for HOMELINK, that God would direct and lead them.



Pray for Prison Fellowship's "Angel Tree Mothers' Day" initiative this month, enabling young offenders in prison to send a card and gift to their mother on Mother's Day. This brings renewed contact and hope. Young offenders are often in custody far from their families and are twice as likely to self-harm in jail as older prisoners. The majority are extremely vulnerable with a range of complex mental health and special educational needs. Pray for the PM to expedite plans to replace Young Offenders Institutes with smaller secure homes around the country, closer to children's families.



LIFE IN ABUNDANCE
INTERNATIONAL

As conflict in the DRC disrupts daily life, join LIA-DRC in prayer that God will restore normality, especially in Goma, so that schools and essential services can resume. With the M23 fighters advancing, pray for divine intervention and a swift humanitarian ceasefire as well as God's protection over the LIA-DRC team and wisdom to navigate this difficult season.



We give thanks to our team of dedicated chaplains who deal with a range of different and often very challenging interventions at Beachy Head. Please pray that in each encounter the Holy Spirit will guide and equip them to start a dialogue to encourage a more hopeful solution than suicide.



The Family Support Work continues to offer both practical and emotional support for families in need in the Chichester Diocese area. In January they recorded 253 visits to families and 972 remote calls and organised 80 group sessions and 83 food deliveries. Despite a reduction in their funding they are still praying for the appointment of another senior practitioner for the Hastings area. They are planning fundraising events for 2025 including a Quiz night, a sponsored walk, a choir concert and a Barn Dance. Families value the service of FSW giving them hope in difficult times.



Please pray for the Open the Book teams in Lewes, as they take God's word into Southover and South Malling Schools on 11th and 25th of March. Pray that the children will enjoy and remember the stories and that they will be led closer to Jesus in their personal lives.

Please pray for Chaplains taking God's word into prisons, many are using the Romans bible course produced by the society. Pray that many people would come to a personal faith in Jesus and that their lives would be transformed.



The Leprosy Mission

This month we have been asked to pray for Nepal. For Anandaban hospital, for wisdom for the team as they look to the future.

Give thanks for female health volunteers raising awareness about Leprosy and combatting the stigma.
